

Liberia Restoration Branches and Missions Celebrate 1st Anniversary

Greetings from all the Saints in Liberia. Sunday, February 26, 2006, was a joyous day to have celebrated our first anniversary under the guidance of the Holy Spirit and in the bond of peace and unity as we enter a new Liberia and the rapid spreading of the restored gospel begins to take root. The Spirit is really at work in Liberia. We continue to receive invitations to visit areas that the restoration gospel has not reached. We are praying and trusting God to lead us in obeying the Great Commission.

The celebration brought together over one hundred adults and about one hundred fifteen children. We had the program live on Radio One, and a recording was done by Radio Gbezohn which was later played on their subsequent program and covered in the news hour.

A baptism of 16 persons took place at the Benson River, in the morning, before the anniversary program started. Elder Stephen G* and Elder Daniel B* performed the baptisms. Their confirmation is still pending due to the nature of the program, and the time constraints.

Elder Stephen G* of the Monrovia Restoration Mission gave the spoken word under the theme: "Live a Life that is worthy of your calling", taken from Ephesians 4:1-13, and Elder Joshua K* presided over the Anniversary Celebration.
