We are grateful to God for your prayer for the work in Liberia. Pray with us as we will be celebrating our First Anniversary at the end of February 2006.

Elder Mark T* and Bro. Wilfred M*s' trip to Sinoe County, February 2-9, 2006 is highlighted in this report.

Though this should now be dry season as you know, we have had lots of rain since December, as if we are still in the rainy season. I think you can imagine the road to Sinoe County. It is worse than ever before. Just imagine being over the carrier of a pickup truck or a 4WD Jeep. They had lots of difficulties. Walking from Koons Town to Dutour Compound to Teah Town was not an easy task. The walk between these towns varies from two to three hours, and that is the normal routine of Bro. Gabriel.

According to Elder Mark T*, the Community of Christ people invited Gabriel to a meeting and accused him of taking their members. There he stood at a cross-road to make a final decision which he had yet to make until Bro. Mark's arrival. He was so excited together with the others to see representatives from the Restoration church after a long time.

We are considering sending two persons to stay in Sinoe for a long term missionary work. A month, two or three, depending on the provision of the Lord. We have gathered that the work in Sinoe County needs more attention. Pray with us as we pray for Bro. Gabriel and the work in Sinoe to get at least a small motorcycle that cost \$600.00. This could enable Bro. Gabriel to move swiftly amongst the branches in existence and the ones that are yet to be started or restored. (Note: The church has decided to send one of it's two motorcycles to Sinoe County, for the work there. RV)

Remember that there has been no baptism and ordination in Sinoe County. So our long term stay there will enable us to teach, baptize and ordain priesthood members. The Lord continues to remind us that Sinoe County will be the strength of the work in Liberia. Let us pray that God will lead us in doing His will.
